## Recording Temperature on the Touch Kitchen Production Sheet



- 1. Run the Touch Production Sheet (**Production Reports > Kitchen Production Sheet**).
- 2. For the menu item whose temperature is to be recorded, tap its **Record** button for **Cook**. The Record Temperature pop-up appears.
- 3. If needed, tap **F** or **C** to record the temperature in Fahrenheit or Celsius, respectively.
- 4. If using a Bluetooth® thermometer probe, insert the probe into the food and press its Record button. The temperature is automatically recorded in the **Temperature** field.

Or to manually enter the temperature, tap into the **Temperature** field, and the pop-up changes to the number pad for you to enter the temperature and then tap **Submit**.

- 5. In the **Staff name** field, enter your name. Note that if you had previously entered your name, the system remembers it.
- 6. Click the **Add Temperature** button. You are returned to the main screen, where the newly-recorded temperature is listed for the item.
- If corrective action is required on the temperature, use the other temperature **Record** buttons to record the temperature.
